The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) reports space heaters can be used effectively as long as the following safety precautions are followed:

Choose a space heater that has been tested to safety standards

Select a space heater with a guard around the flame area or heating element

Use in a wellventilated area if the unit is unventilated

Install a smoke alarm with fresh batteries

Turn off the heater if leaving the area

Have a fire extinguisher handy

Place heater near combustible materials—clothes, drapes, furniture, etc

Use underrated or damaged electrical connectors with electric heaters

Use gasoline in place of kerosene or propane

DON'T Go to sleep with the heater on

DON'T Allow children to operate heate

Use heater to dry clothes

All safety procedures on the use of portable space heaters should be reviewed prior to use. Manufacturers, local fire departments, and consumer safety groups are valuable sources of material.
